Hangin' Around Fired Arts Overview

The annual Fired Arts show theme is objects that hang. All media that require high heat (1,000°F) to be completed are encouraged to enter. These include ceramics, glass, and metal. This show will highlight items that hang on the wall. Freestanding fired arts works that fit the theme will also be considered. Some suggestions for objects include; mirrors, wind chimes, wall planters or vases, hanging planters or bird baths, masks, things that fly, and bird houses. All pieces must be ready to hang and weigh no more than 20 pounds.

Submission Guidelines

All entries for show must be original pieces created by the artist. No molded pieces, painted ceramics, or embellished premade objects will be accepted. Art work should not have been exhibited previously at Paradise Art Center. All works should be for sale. See Specifications on reverse for additional information regarding submissions.

Gallery Docents and Reception Contributions

All artists showing work at this exhibition are required to act as gallery docents for at least one weekend shift. A signup sheet will be available at drop off. All exhibitors will also be asked to contribute refreshments for the reception.

Wheeler Gallery Commission

All exhibited work should be for sale. Artists agree to a 25% commission to the Paradise Art Center for sales resulting from this exhibition, including sales of matted prints and other exhibited items. Sales tax will be collected and paid by the Paradise Art Center. Any works submitted as not for sale will be shown at the discretion of the gallery committee, space permitting.

Specifications

Freestanding pieces may not weigh more than 75 pounds.

Wall pieces may not weight more than 20 pounds.

Any wall pieces must have a secure hanging system. Works must be ready to display with no additional preparation required by the gallery committee. The Paradise Art Center reserves the right to reject a work unfit for exhibit. All art work must have the artist's name, title of work, and price attached to the piece.

Liability

Paradise Art Center assumes no responsibility for loss or damage incurred.

Every reasonable precaution will be taken during the receiving, installation, exhibition, and return of work. Artists should carry their own insurance. Work should not be so fragile that public display is potentially harmful to the work or the viewer.

Image Release

Paradise Art Center reserves the right to photograph entries for purposes of documentation, education, and publicity.

Delivery

All artwork must be hand-delivered to Paradise Art Center, 5564 Almond Street, Paradise, during the dates and times specified. Please **DO NOT** drop off work at other times without making arrangements with the gallery committee.

Matted Prints (No Originals)

Participating and member artists may bring matted prints to sell during this and other shows. Print racks are provided by the gallery. Prints must be wrapped in plastic sleeves and marked with your name, title, and price of the work. All proceeds of sales of prints without identifying information will go to the Paradise Art Center. Prints are to remain in Wheeler Gallery no longer than two months.
