process of making repeatable forms and surface decoration with templating. We will practice various ways of handle clay and discuss the pros/cons of each process. We will practice forms such as mugs, bowls, trays/platers/plates with a foot ring. We will create a template together, use slump molds and learn about tools, materials and ways to troubleshoot creating wares in clay. 4-week sessions.
