# **Member Spotlight - Christiane and Walter Beeler**

The article for this issue of the Paradise Art Center Newsletter highlights not only one, but two Art Center members, Christiane and Walter Beeler. Walter and Christiane have been members of Paradise Art Center since 2005 and 2006 respectively. Walter joined to further his knowledge of watercolor painting and began taking classes with Kathy Presentati. Christiane often sat knitting during Walter's watercolor classes and when Kathy encouraged her to join the class Christiane agreed thinking, "Oh well, if I don't like it, I do not have to stay!" Christiane stayed learning the basics of painting with

watercolor and has continued painting on her own and with Walter's guidance to the present. Both have exhibited their work at Nic's and the Wheeler Gallery and Walter has also exhibited at the Orland Art Center.

Walter's early art experience was through the normal art programs offered through his 12 years of public education. He took one oil painting class in college, but states that most of his experience in art came from his technical/mechanical drawing training. Christiane grew up in France, "surrounded by beautiful art but I was rather an observer but not a doer." French elementary schools did not include studio art in the curriculum. Years ago, she took Butte



College classes in art appreciation, drawing and oil painting. None of those classes inspired her to continue. The good news is that Christiane's artistic journey led her to the Paradise Art Center.

Walter and Christiane both have distinctive styles and when asked what media each enjoyed most, their responses were as follows; Walter has tried oil, acrylic, watercolor and pen and ink and most enjoys watercolor and pen and ink separately or in combination. Christiane enjoys doing detail work with watercolor and is currently learning to use different techniques to get various backgrounds.

They sometimes see a photo or something in nature that inspires them and they then begin the creative process by thinking how each would like their own version to develop. This includes designing the background, composition and what colors to use. In planning the painting, Walter pays "particular attention to the juxtaposition of the major objects and how they create tension in the composition.

It is this tension that brings cohesion and movement to the picture." Both agree that it is very important to work out the final composition of the painting on tracing paper to avoid extensive erasing on the watercolor paper. When the final drawing is complete, it can easily be transferred to the watercolor paper and the painting can begin.

Both these artists have other creative interests. Christiane has knitted since the age of 7, making her first vest at 9 years of age. She has continued to knit sweaters for men, women, children, and babies as well as blankets, dishcloths, washcloths and many other projects. Walter has enjoyed woodworking, woodcarving and pottery, although he has stopped woodworking due to health issues.

It is always interesting to find out what artists our members follow. Both Christiane and Walter enjoy watching YouTube artists Anna Mason, Louise de Masi, Yong Chen and the Mind of Watercolor channel on YouTube. It is evident that they both feel art is very important in their lives but add that just as important are the people you get to meet with the same interests you have. Walter commented that "if you can sign your name, you're already demonstrating that you can do art" and Christiane added "If I can do it, anyone can do it as well".

Lastly, they "both feel that it is vitally important to a community to have an active art center where people can learn to do art, do art and share with family, the community and others. "We are very pleased to have been members of PAC for all these years and all the relationships we have developed there". Members of the Art Center that know Walter and Christiane or have seen their work are equally pleased to have this committed and creative art couple members of the Paradise Art Center.

# **Partners in Art Fundraising**

The Fundraising committee continues to work hard to raise money for the Art Center.

In the Fall of 2023, we created "Partners in Art" as our overarching fundraising slogan. We are each a Partner in supporting the Art Center as we donate our time, energy, money and artwork. We are Partners as we share our talents, serve on committees, volunteer for and attend events.

The major focus of our fundraising efforts this past year has been our "Partners in Art – Raise the Roof "campaign, addressing the urgent need for funds to reframe and replace our roof plus take care of multiple, newly discovered, infrastructure construction needs. Thanks to the generosity of our members, special donors and support from the community, we have raised almost all of the needed \$87,000 needed for our Raise the Roof campaign.

Our May fundraiser at Mountain Mike's was fun and well attended. Direct donations received were \$680 and proceeds from Mt. Mike's orders that night was \$266.33 for a total of almost \$1,000.

Our 2nd annual Art Auction was held in June at the Art Center. Thanks to the generosity of our participating artists and event attendees, this event raised nearly \$6500. Kudos to Greg Sanchez for organizing another successful auction.

In June we held a music fundraiser Hammers & Eamp; Harmony. Thanks to the generosity of Theatre on the Ridge and the donation of time and talent from all of the musicians, we raised almost \$1400.

We hosted Wine Tasting fundraisers in both August and November, raising a total of \$2400. We are grateful to Grocery Outlet for guiding and supporting us in this effort.

Special thanks to our dedicated 2024 committee members Patti Lloyd, Diana McCollum, Ann Slocum, Lori Phelps-Zink, Pam Hartley and Greg Sanchez.
